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### ABC of Ohio Legislative Tracking

- HB1 PROPERTY, INCOME TAX CHANGES (MATHEWS A) To modify the law regarding property taxation and income tax rates.  
Current Status: 4/25/2023 - House Ways and Means, (Seventh Hearing)
- HB2 LEGISLATIVE INTENT-STATE FUNDING (CUTRONA A, UPCHURCH T) To declare the intent of the General Assembly to direct state funds to projects across the state for economic growth and community development.  
Current Status: 2/16/2023 - Referred to Committee House Finance
- HB23 TRANSPORTATION BUDGET (EDWARDS J) To make appropriations for programs related to transportation for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025, and to provide authorization and conditions for the operation of those programs.  
Current Status: 3/31/2023 - SIGNED BY GOVERNOR; eff. 3/31/23
- HB129 REQUIRE LICENSURE OF COMMERCIAL ROOFING CONTRACTORS (PATTON T) To require licensure of commercial roofing contractors and to amend the versions of sections 715.27 and 3781.102 of the Revised Code that are scheduled to take effect on December 29, 2023, to continue the change on and after that date.

- HB134 REQUIRE NOTICE TO LIENHOLDERS (DELL'AQUILA R, GALONSKI T) To require notice to lienholders in tax certificate sales.

- HB168 OHIO ADULT USE ACT (CALLENDER J, WEINSTEIN C) To enact the Ohio Adult Use Act and to levy a tax.  
Current Status: 5/23/2023 - Referred to Committee House Finance
- HB176 OHIO CARPENTERS LICENSE PLATE (GRIM M) To revise the "Ohio Carpenters" license plate.  
Current Status: 5/23/2023 - Referred to Committee House Homeland Security
- HB187 PROPERTY TAX SALES-ASSESSMENT RATIO STUDIES (HALL T, BIRD A) To modify the procedures used by the Tax Commissioner to conduct property tax sales-assessment ratio studies.  
Current Status: 5/24/2023 - Introduced
- SB3 COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION PROGRAM (SCHURING K) To create the Ohio Community Revitalization Program, authorizing nonrefundable income tax credits for undertaking community projects.  
Current Status: 1/17/2023 - Referred to Committee Senate Ways and Means
- SB23 PURCHASING AUTHORITY-CONSTRUCTION SERVICES (LANG G) To expand political subdivision joint purchasing authority to expressly include purchases for construction services.  
Current Status: 4/19/2023 - REPORTED OUT, Senate Government Oversight, (Fourth Hearing)
- SB30 YOUTH WORKING HOURS (SCHAFFER T) To allow a person under sixteen years of age to be employed after 7 p.m. during the school year.  
Current Status: 5/9/2023 - REPORTED OUT, House Commerce and Labor, (Fourth Hearing)
- SB41 LAW CHANGES-BUILDING INSPECTIONS (ROEGNER K) To make changes to the law relating to building inspections.  
Current Status: 5/9/2023 - House Economic and Workforce Development, (First Hearing)

- SB47 LEAVE USE PROHIBITION-UNION ACTIVITIES (HUFFMAN S) To prohibit a public employer from providing paid leave or compensation for a public employee to engage in certain union activities.  
Current Status: 2/8/2023 - Referred to Committee Senate Judiciary
- SB96 LABOR LAW NOTICES-POSTING (LANG G, WILSON S) To allow employers to post certain labor law notices on the internet.  
Current Status: 3/29/2023 - Referred to Committee Senate Workforce and Higher Education
- SB119 WASTE DISPOSAL LAW CHANGES (REINEKE W) To make changes to the laws governing the transfer and disposal of solid waste and construction and demolition debris, including increasing certain fees.  
Current Status: 5/23/2023 - Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources, (Second Hearing)
- SCR2 URGE CONGRESS-YOUTH WORK (SCHAFFER T) To urge Congress to make changes to the Fair Labor Standards Act to allow a person under 16 years of age to be employed between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m. during the school year.  
Current Status: 5/9/2023 - REPORTED OUT, House Commerce and Labor, (Third Hearing)
- SJR2 CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE-60 PERCENT REQUIREMENT (MCCOLLEY R, GAVARONE T) Proposing to amend Sections 1b, 1e, and 1g of Article II and Sections 1 and 3 of Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to require a vote of at least 60% of the electors to approve any constitutional amendment.
